With healthcare professional (HCP) refers to a doctor, dentist, pharmacist, nurse or other staff in the health sector who is entitled to prescribe, purchase, supply, recommend or administer medications, including an employee of pharmaceutical companies whose principal employment is in health and health care. Other employees of pharmaceutical companies or pharmaceutical distributor is not covered by the concept of health professionals.

With healthcare (HCO) means any legal entity which operates health care or research or teaching in this area, or is a professional organization with medical or scientific orientation, with the exception of the association referred to in LER Chapter 3.al.

With the transfer of value for research and development provided for distributions to beneficiaries in planning or execution of (i) non-clinical study (defined in the OECD Principles of Good Laboratory Practice), (ii) clinical trial, or (iii) non-interventional study involving collection of patient data from health professionals or on their behalf.
